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Discovering Algeria

Algeria is a huge country of 2,300,000 km², which is almost a continent! Algeria with its 1200 km of coastline and 6,000 km of borders along with Tunisia, Libya, Niger, Mali, Mauritania, Western Sahara, Morocco, is now a booming tourist destination. Here, everything is moving, changing, becoming something everything shows a spectacle and recreation, birth, collective creation...

At the dawn of history, Algeria is inhabited by Berbers known as Libyan or Amazigh. They are nomads and sedentary people respectively that know writing (characters are similar to those of Tifinagh used by current Tuareg), drawing in addition to simple advanced graves: Bazina. During the first state organization of Algeria, the same was called Numidia and several generations of Berber kings have governed it from Syfax to Juba II.

From 12th Century before Christ, the Phoenicians settled on the coast and constructed the much talked-about forts that will help to influence an area predestined to trade, commerce and universal relations.

After the destruction of Carthage in 146 before Christ and the victory of Rome over the Numidian kingdoms, the northern part of Algeria becomes part of the African provinces of the Roman Empire. There are still archaeological evidences which are prominent in the cultural heritage of Algeria.

You should see the military housing estates of Timgad Lambes, the beautiful and soft Djemila near Setif, or those coastal homes giving bright image to Tipaza.

In the 7th Century, Arab conquest begins and results to final change due to massive rally to Islam.

Then comes the Turkish regency established in the 16th Century with which there would be a maritime history that the legend will continue to enhance.

Many years were required, after the landing of French troops in 1830, to overcome the national resistance. However, after more than a century of colonization, the insurrection broke out on 1st November 1954 and led to independence on July 5th, 1962.

Today Algeria is an entity, a young and dynamic state, but continues to assert the diversity that reveals also a way of life and explaining the world. The emphasis is on many sectors deemed to be essential:

education, agriculture, housing...

More over, the means of this policy exist. With regard to education, a constant battle has been led so that Algeria will get quickly a workforce increasingly qualified. There can be no better representation of the development of education and culture in Algeria than the groups of these thousands of children who, at any hour of the day, take the route to school or return from the same. Regularly new classes, new sets are created.

Children are everywhere and symbolizes the country: of primary school or at the gates of the university, they take impetuously all the population towards a perpetual reappraisal of all systems and aim for new values. There are many universities in Algiers, Oran, Constantine, Annaba, Batna, Tizi Ouzou, Tlemcen...

It is an ambitious undertaking to present many faces of Algeria.

The sandy beaches alternate with high green cliffs that cover the coastal road; that of Dahra, west between Mostaganem, Tenes and Cherchell (ancient Caesarea); in addition to Chenoua between Cherchell and Tipaza and then that of Sahej up to Algiers, in the east, there is a mountain road of Kabyle from Dellys to Bejaia, from Tychy to Jijel. Parallel to the coastline, there are tells of Atlas, followed by green area and cedar forests that provide shade and coolness in the heat of summer.

In the center, there are mountains of Ouarsenis (1985m), Kef Righa (1714m), Chréa (1510m), Titteri, the chain of Hodna and Djurdjura of nearly 3000 m.

Inlow-lying and strictly parallel to the Atlas Tells, there is Saharan Atlas of 2300 m with Kasours, Djebel Amour, Ouled Nail Mountains.



Between the two Atlas, the highlands goes on further as far as the Alta, Sersou plateau and mainly the Aures massif or throne to 2328 m, Jebel Chelia.

Finally the Sahara, though to be flat, monotonous and empty, is however living, changing, magical. The silence, the white and ochre houses, waves of sand, space, also traces of greenery and oasis life, erg, Hammada, dunes, so many magic words to explain this world in which is the Hoggar, of more than 3000 m, dominates, and is carrying messages from civilizations thousands of years old (rock paintings and carvings ...). And here is the blue sky of a legendary region that continues to amaze even those who are the most jaded and make them dream.

The different civilizations which were in Algeria for centuries, have left traces of exceptional values in this country, once considered as the granary of Rome, the remains are scattered throughout the territory in Cherchell, Djemila, Tingad and Tébessa.

We must admire the Kaïla of Beni Hammed, battlements of Almoravids, Almohads or Fatimid in addition to minarets and mosques of Tlemcen, the palaces of Bey and Deys, the Casbah of Algiers and Constantine. The museums also offer to visitors eyes treasures that tell about the incredible era of a people and country. Collections of sculptures, paintings, mosaics, crafts are in this way presented in the many museums of history and archeology.

We should not forget the rock paintings of Tassili that belong to an era of mysterious world ! Algeria attracts visitors throughout the year thanks to its exceptional climate; it is possible to relax in any season and the sun shines almost constantly.

During the long weeks of winter and on the snowy peaks, you can ski in the equipped ski resorts of Chréa, Tikjda et Tale Guilaf.

The forests are refuge of peace and solitude. There is an impressive place of interest and villages are built like hives on the peaks, moreover the hammam, being a hot springs, are opened to cure magically all ills.

Large holiday complexes, hotels, bungalows are available to everybody. Oases, seaside resort and ski resorts are equipped with equipments tailored to diverse needs and then there's the adventure of the South that we can talk about later, naturally after preparing well its expedition.

The architectural ideas are admirable; the simple and symbolic decorations give an authentic ambience and make, of these new buildings, an original works, moreover they are perfectly functional and contain playgrounds, tennis, pool and all shops where the visitor will find a full range of handicrafts, carpets of thick wool and knotted wool, the burnous, the piece of arabesques embroideries with flowers, with gold thread, silver on velvet, silk or leather.

The basket-making which decor is similar that of pottery, carved furniture, leather and skin clothing, copper plates, silver or golden jewelry of Beni Yenni with coral, we should not forget the beautiful and unusual sand roses.

A highly developed infrastructure offers a range of transportation choices.

The well-equipped airports enables to travel quickly between remote areas, the road network, trans-Sahara road in the south and eastern highway encourage numerous excursions, whether by car, bus and all ground conditions vehicles.

The rail network crosses the country from east to west and connects the major cities of North and South regions.

There are domes of mosques, factories' chimneys and mild evenings, the old people are gathered on the sidewalks and their eyes are squinting in the glare of the sun, moreover on the way home, the children throw their bags on the grass and sit for a moment on the hill surrounded by sheep, besides somewhere out of sight, there is a woman paying in silence. The fingers of people picking dates take a lot time to gather the dates. Around wells, spread a strange light that gives everything unknown reliefs.



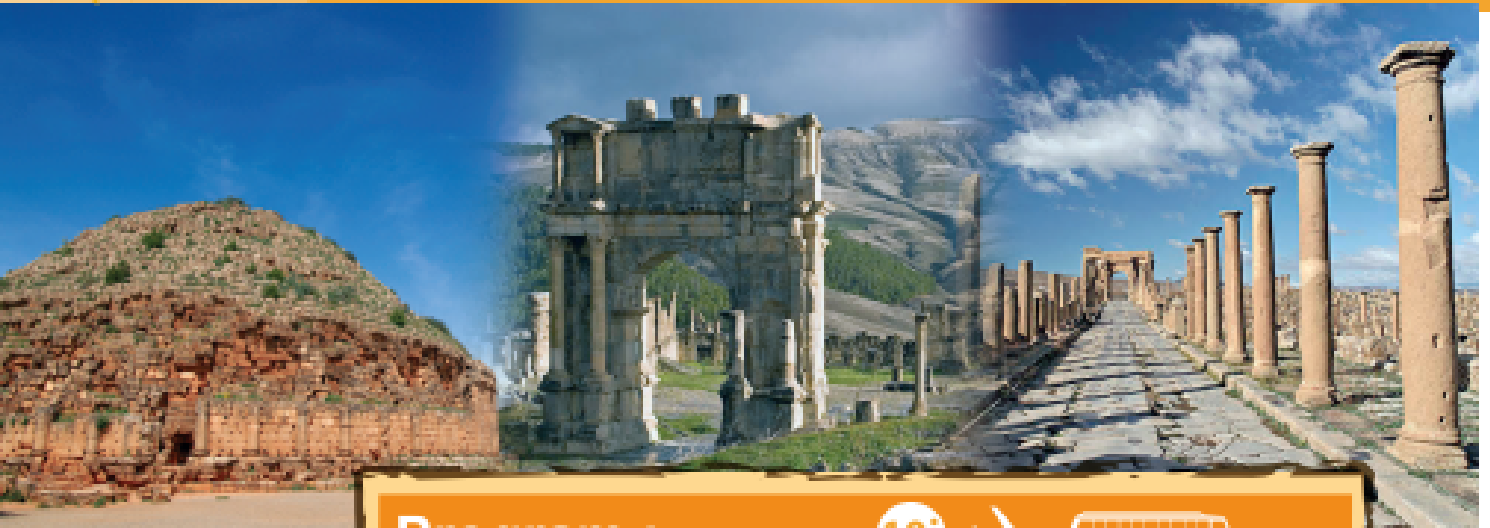

First Day : Algiers

Reception at Algiers airport, city tour and discovery of Algiers; visit of "Bastion 23" or "Rais Palace" edified at the end of the XVII century, discovery of Notre Dame d'Afrique Cathedral overlooking the bay. Night in Algiers.

Second Day : Algiers

Discovery of the old city "Casbah", with all its streets and low houses.

El Djazair recalls also the Barberousse - Berbers piracy and the Ottoman Sultan suzerainty, then visit of Beaux-Arts museum that houses works of art of Flemish, Italian and French artists from the XIV and XIX century. Overnight in Algiers.

Third Day : Algiers / Cherchell / Tipaza / Algiers

Departure to Cherchell, the ancient Caesarea, built by Juba II, king of Numidia.

Visit the "park of mosaic museum " the Tour wll continue with the visit of Tipaza, ancient trading post, visit of the archeological park, that combines ruins and seaside nature, and where is located the Frescos Villa of Tipaza City. Finally, discovery of the Royal Mausoleum of Mauretania, overlooking the sea from the top of a hill and surrounded by olives trees. Return and overnight in Algiers.

Fourth Day : Algiers / Djami'a / Sétif

Departure to Djami'a, " The Beautiful " in Arabic, on the most interesting antique site in Algeria. The ruins of the roman city "Cuicul" built under Emperor Nerva, in the first century, and is part of rugged landscape. Visit of the museum housing the objects found on the site. Sétif does not lack charm, with its places, large avenues lined with arcades and gardens, visit the National Museum. Overnight in Sétif.

Fifth Day : Setif / Constantine

Departure for Constantine. Most of the old city monuments were built during the Ottoman Era, except the Great Mosque, which dates from the XIX century. View of the different bridge that spans the Rummel Gorges, beside which the city was edified. Overnight in Constantine.

Sixth Day : Constantine / Timgad / Batna

Between Constantine and Batna, the Aures Mountains Citadel opens its doors. Stop at Medracen and then continue the tour towards Timgad, that was founded in the year 100 under the reign of Trajan. The city is listed among the World Heritage of Unesco and is very well conserved, saved by sand and oblivion. visit the museum and the archeological site overnight in Batna.

Seventh Day : Batna / Khenchla / Tebessa

Departure to Khenchla, which is an important gateway to the Aures, Namenchla plateaus, continue the visit towards Tebessa, that was founded by the Vespasien at the end of the first century. Two prestigious buildings that reflects the apogee of the city : from one side the "Arc of Caracalla" which dates from 212, the temple and the museum named "Minerve" from the other side . Overnight in Tebessa.

Eighth Day : Tebessa / Khemissa / Madaure / Guelma

Discovery of Khemissa, which contains interesting vestige of the roman era, the visit will continue towards Madaure, the old Numide city, edified as Roman colony, where Saint Augustin studied. Visit of Guelma, a Numide city before it becomes a municipality under Trajan colony and a Roman colony at the end of the III century. From its Roman past, the city maintained the theatre whose scene wall is still in excellent condition. Overnight in Guelma.

Ninth Day : Guelma / Hippo / Annaba

Visit the ancient Roman city of Hippo. The vestiges are scattered among the fig trees, including the Basilica of Peace of St. Augustine. Its archaeological museum houses many sculptures and mosaics. Visit the Basilica of St. Augustine of Hippo overlooking the ruins. Continue the tour to Annaba. Overnight in Annaba.

The Constantine region and the Oasis

Program :



First Day : Algiers

Arrival at Algiers, reception at Algiers Houari Boumediene airport. Transfer to the package hotel. Check in, dinner and night.

Second Day : Tipaza / Cherchell

After breakfast, departure from the hotel to visit the Royal Mauritanian Tomb located on the coastal hills of western Algiers at about 260 m above sea level and which offers a panoramic view of the coastline on the north and Mirdja plain on the south. Continue the tour in the ancient port of Carthage in Tipaza with its punic tomb. Visit of the museum site of this city with its collection of glasses, mosaic of captives and sarcophagi of great artistic value. Discovery of the ancient city of Tipaza with its theatres, amphitheater, pagan temples and Christian edifices, the baptistery and cemeteries that are unique in the ancient world. Breakfast at Tipaza hotel. In the afternoon, city tour of Cherchell, ancient capital of Caesarian Mauretania called Caesarea, after having been called Iole during the Phoenician era. Visit the port and the mosaic park. Return to hotel. Dinner and overnight.

Third Day : Tipaza / Setif

After breakfast, departure to Setif through the gorges of Lakhdaria (eg Palestro) that mark the Tellian transition areas to the Cereals highlands on Eastern side of the countries. Late morning Arrive to Setif. Ancient Setif, capital of Setifian Mauretania. Check in at the hotel (full board). In the afternoon, excursion to Djamilia, the former Cuicul created during the reign of the Emperor Nerva in 96 and considered one of the most beautiful cities on the edges Mediterranean, during the Roman era. Visit the Baptistery, the temple of Severus, the theater's famous Serlius markets and Museum, famous for its rich collection of mosaics. Back to Setif in late afternoon.

Fourth Day : Setif / Constantine

After breakfast, departure for Constantine, the ancient Ciria. Orientation tour and transfer to the hotel. Visit the museum. In the afternoon, departure to Tiddis, a site of exceptional beauty. Crossing the Cereals regions of eastern Algeria. The discovery of Tiddis that is clinging to red day cliffs of the region and descend steep valley. Important Roman city at the time of Augustus (third century) that experienced a genuine growth during the Muslim period Hafiste (tenth century). Excavations carried out to update the Roman city have forever altered these vestiges, except a few pieces, kept today in the museum of Constantine.

Fifth Day : Constantine / Annaba / Guelma

After breakfast, departure to Annaba, the ancient Hippo at the mouth of the Oued Seybouse bordered by the Eddough massif, on the sole coastal plain of eastern Algeria. City tour and Hippo museum visit with its splendid mosaics, and especially its famous bronze trophy, unique existent piece in the Roman world representing a headless body with a height of 2.45m. Breakfast at hotel. In the afternoon, departure to Guelma. Visit during the tour of the hot springs of Hammam Meshkoutine and its wonderful petrified waterfall and the ancient theater of Guelma. Check in at your hotel. Dinner and overnight.

Sixth Day : Guelma / Batna

After breakfast, departure to Batna. Visit during the tour of the vast Berber mausoleum built prior to Roman era. "The Medracen". Check in at your hotel. In the afternoon, visit Tazoult, located on the site of the ancient Lambaesis (second century) who became the capital of Numidia under Septimius Severus, an area of no less than 800 hectares. Visit Timgad Roman city that homes great value vestiges.

Seventh Day : Batna / Biskra

After breakfast, departure to Biskra, crossing the gorges of El Kantara, colorful parade that marks the entrance of the Sahara. Check in at Zibans hotel in Biskra (full board). In the afternoon visit Rouff or Mechtas balconies are hanging on the walls of the canyon of Wadi El-Abiod whose bottom is lined with palm trees. Return late afternoon to Biskra. Free time in center of the city.

Eighth Day : Biskra / Bou-Saada / Algiers

After breakfast, departure to Bou-Saada. Visit the Zaouia El-Hamel and the Ferrero mill. Lunch at hotel. In the afternoon, departure to Algiers. Dinner and overnight at package the hotel.

Ninth Day : Departure

After breakfast, transfer to Algiers airport. Assistance for departure.

From Thagaste to Hyppo-Regius

Augustine of Hippo (Latin: Aurelius Augustinus), or Saint Augustine, born in the municipality of Thagaste (now Souk-Ahras, Algeria) on November 13th, 354 and died on August 28th, 430 at Hippo (now Annaba, Algeria) is a Christian theologian and philosopher of late antiquity, Bishop of Hippo, a writer and Latin Berber Roman-African, his father was a Romano-African (African Romanized) Roman citizen and his mother was non-Romanized Berber, St. Monica.

He is one of the four Latin Fathers of the Church (with St. Ambrose, St. Jerome and Gregory I) and one of 33 doctors of the Church. As a philosopher, he is considered a Christian Platonist, often close to Plotinus.

Program :



First Day : Algiers

Arrival to Algiers, city tour and check in at the hotel (half board).

Second Day : Algiers

Visit the main monuments: Riad El-Feth (Victory Park), superb views over the bay of Algiers, and the Colonial City, visit the National Museum of Antiquities, the Palace Rais, in the afternoon passing by the Casbah, visit the traditional art museum, back for dinner and overnight at the hotel.

Third Day : Algiers / Setif / Constantine

After breakfast, departure to Setif passing by the highlands, arriving in the morning to the ancient Sétifs, visit the old Djamila Cuicul built during the reign of the Emperor Nerva in 96 and considered as one of the most beautiful Mediterranean cities in the Roman times. Visit the site and museum, famous for its rich collection of mosaics, and continue the tour in the late afternoon to Constantine the ancient Cirta. Orientation tour and check in at the hotel.

Fourth Day : Constantine / Annaba

In the morning visit the museum of Constantine, the bridge of Sidi-MCid and Emir Abdalkader mosque and departure to Annaba. After breakfast visit the ruins and the museum and continue to visit St. Augustine Basilica and the Annabi coast to contemplate the sunset on the coast guard, dinner and overnight at the hotel.

Fifth Day : Annaba / Souk Ahras

After breakfast departure for Ahras souk or "ancient Thagaste" homeland of St. Monica mother of St. Augustine, this Berber is born in the country and is considered as one of the greatest thinker of the Catholic Church. Visit the small museum and the olive tree, after lunch departure for M'darouch visit the archaeological site and return to Souk Ahras, dinner and overnight at the hotel.

Sixth Day : Souk Ahras / Tebessa

After breakfast, departure to Tebessa, the ancient Theveste, lunch during the tour, visit the walls that surround the old town, dating from the sixth century and the door of Solomon, visit the Roman Temple of third century, and the great Christian basilica of St. Crispina. Dinner and overnight at Tebessa.

Seventh Day : Tebessa / Khemissa / Guelma.

After breakfast, departure to the archaeological site of Khemissa visit to the theater, and the Basilica, lunch during the tour and continue the visit to the city of Guelma, Numidian city before becoming a municipality under Trajan, dinner and overnight at the hotel.

Eighth Day : Guelma / Annaba

After breakfast departure to hammam Debagh, visit waterfalls with a temperatures of 95 ° C, one of the hottest in the world, then return to Guelma, visit the museum and the Roman theater where we will see beautiful statues of Jupiter and Esculapes. Lunch and return to Annaba. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

Ninth Day : Departure

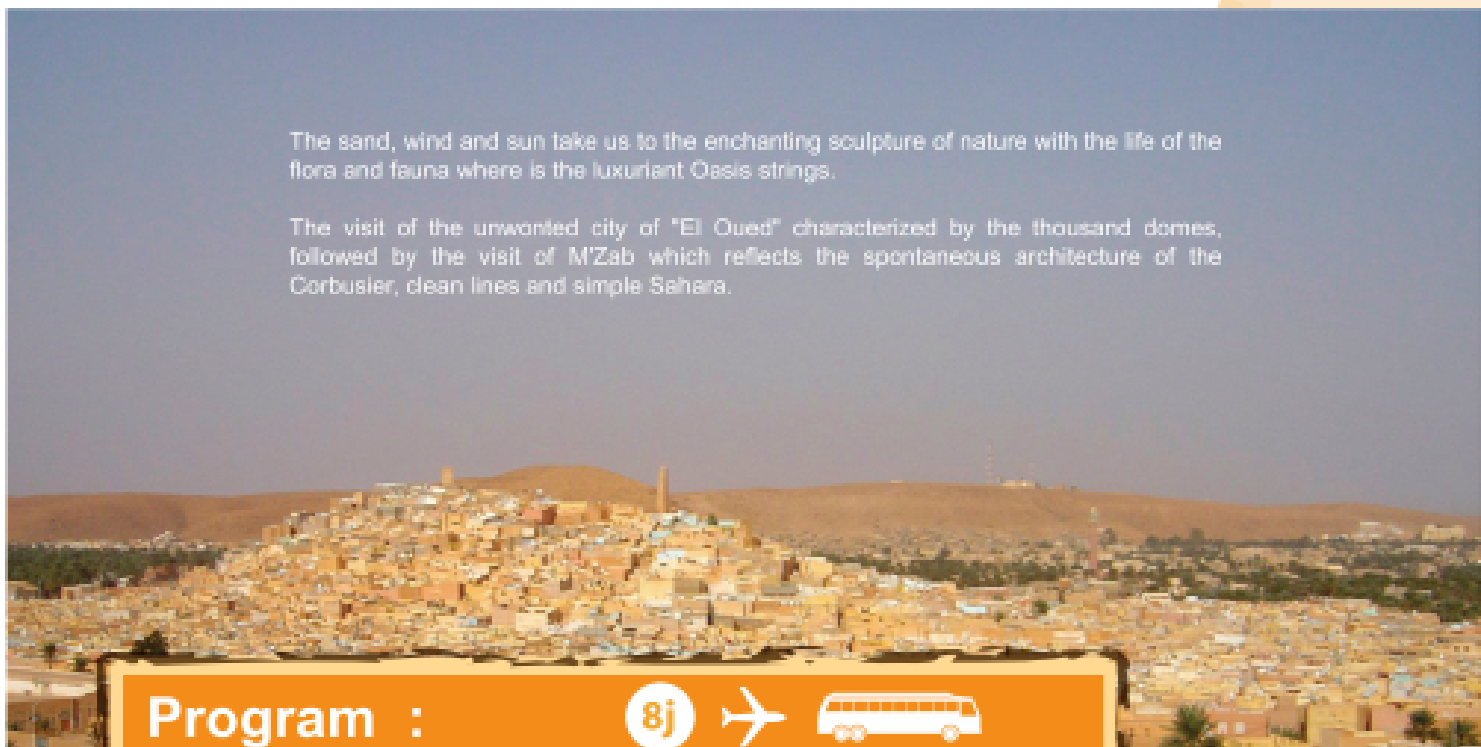

The visit of the unworled city of "El Oued" characterized by the thousand domes, followed by the visit of M'Zab which reflects the spontaneous architecture of the Corbusier, clean lines and simple Sahara.

First Day : Algiers

Reception at Algiers airport of Houari Boumediene. Transfer to package hotel. Dinner and night stay in the hotel.

Second Day : Algiers / Bou-Saada / Biskra

In the morning, travel to Bou-Saada through the Gorges of Chiffa which mark the boundary between the northern Mediterranean and highland with steppes that bring the Sahara. In the afternoon, travel to old versera ; Biskra. On the way, visit of Chaib valley, representing the past that will bring the visitor of highland with steppes to the Sahara. City walk in Biskra then stay in hotel. Dinner and night stay.

Third Day : Biskra / El-Oued

Excursion to Aures mountains followed by the visit of M'Chouneche palm grove and the balconies of Rouffi. Late in the morning, return to Biskra. Free time in the city center. Travel to El-Oued in the afternoon. On the way, visit of Chott El Melghir. Contemplation of the sunset from the dunes on the road to Nekhla. Dinner and night stay in the hotel.

Fourth Day : El Oued / Touggourt

In the morning, visit of the museum and the city of thousand domes with its picturesque market. In the afternoon, travel to Touggourt, across the sea of sand. On the way, visit of Ghoti, that is a small oasis protected from sand with palms. Excursion to Zaouia Tidjani in Tamalhat. Return to Touggourt by Témacine. Free time in the center of Oued Righ. Stay in hotel, dinner and night stay.

Fifth Day : Touggourt / Ouargla /Ghardaia

In the morning, travel to Ghardaia. Visit of Ouargla and Sahara museum of the old city. Free time in the market of sand roses. Further travel up to Ghardaia. In the afternoon, visit of Ghardaia palm grove palm with its dam and sharing system of raw water from the Oued Zab. Visit the holy city of Beni-Isguen and its market of auction. Stay in hotel, dinner and night stay.

Sixth Day : Ghardaia / Laghouat / Bou-Saada

Visit of Ghardaia. Free time and shopping in the town market. Starting around 10 am to Laghouat. On the way, visit of Djelfa and the small village of El-Hamel. Visit of Ferero mill. Late in the afternoon, stay in the hotel of Bou-Saada. Dinner and night stay.

Seventh Day : Bou-Saada / Algiers

Morning travel to Algiers through Lakhdaria Gorges (previously named Palestro). Visit of Riadh El Feth. In the afternoon, there would be city walk. Free time at the lower Casbah , then transfer to hotel in Algiers. Dinner and night stay in hotel.

Eight Day : Departure

After breakfast, transfer to the airport in Algiers. Assistance is provided in the departure.

The M'Zab Valley

The fertile valley of the M'Zab lies at the heart of an arid and rocky region. Green island of ancient culture, it houses a magnificent collection of ksour (castles), fortified villages founded in the tenth century. Harmoniously integrated at the natural landscape, the Mozabites villages are recognizable from a distance, with the top of their walls and colorful houses encircling the mosque. The architecture is only the most visible face, the M'Zab will also reveal in many other ways the nobility of its civilization.

First Day : Algiers / Ghardaia

Panoramic tour of Algiers of which the extent of the white facades, is only equaled by the blue of the Mediterranean Sea that washes upon its coasts. Flight to Ghardaia, called the "gateway to the desert". Overnight in Ghardaia.

Second Day : Ghardaia

Classified as World Heritage by Unesco, the M'Zab is a deep, narrow valley crowned by four cities around Ghardaia: the cities of the Pentapolis. Each stands on mound, along which low buildings and pastel-colored squares climb up to a thin minaret, tower-shaped. The medinas, formed a maze of alleys and covered passageways, that fascinated many Western architects. Discovery of Ghardaia, the largest of the five M'Zab cities. Overnight in Ghardaia.

Third Day : Berriane / Guerrara / Ghardaia

The Mozabites successively founded the cities of El-Ateuf, Bou Noura, Melika, Beni-Isguen and Ghardaia, then in the seventeenth century, ksours Berriane, Guerrara, and Metlili. Visit to Berriane and Guerrara; the two most recent Mozabites cities of the Valley. Overnight in Ghardaia.

Fourth Day : Melika / Bou Noura / Ghardaia

Departure to Melika that homes the cemetery of Sidi Aissa. The white tombs, with conical shapes reminiscent of the turrets, rising at the sky in ghostly way. Continue the visit to Bou Noura, called the light. Its ksar, partially destroyed by a series of internal squabbles, has preserved its ramparts. Night in Ghardaia.

Fifth Day : El Ateuf / Zelfana / Ghardaia

Departure to El Ateuf the oldest Mozabites cities. The mosque of Sidi Brahim, simple white building with curved walls, arches and palm trunk inclined pillars, that would have inspired the chapel Notre-Dame du Haut in Ronchamp to the architect le Corbusier. Continue the visit to Zelfana, green oasis and spa on the banks of the M'Zab river. Overnight in Ghardaia.

Sixth Day : Ghardaia / Beni Isgen / Ghardaia

Walk in the modern Ghardaia where an architectural confrontation took place between Ravereau and Pouillon. Erected on the hillside, Beni Isgen is the most religious of the M'Zab cities. Virtually impervious to outside influences, its population clings to its traditional lifestyle. Sunset from a terrace offering a panoramic view of the Pentapolis and palm groves. Night in Ghardaia.

Seventh Day : Metlili / Ghardaia

Departure for Metlili. Founded by Chaambas, semi-nomads who roamed the northern Sahara and often conflicted with Mozabites, the city homes palm grove, a genuine garden paradise, where rock engravings were discovered. Night in Ghardaia.

Eighth Day : Ghardaia / Algiers

Boarding at the airport to flight to Algiers.

The Gardens of the Saoura

The Saoura peppers the picturesque oasis along the roads of Mauritania. The traveler can choose in the immensity of rolling and ochres dunes of the Great Western erg, the palm groves of the Touat Between each oasis, lies the vastness, the unknown, the strange and magic. No one can hide his emotion, no one can remain indifferent to this eternal silence, this infinite space, a lush oasis and sand sea. Touat and Gourara offer to the viewers one of the most typical architecture of the Sahara.

First Day : Algiers

Arrival at Algiers airport Houari Boumediene. Transfer to the package hotel. Check in, dinner and overnight stay.

Second Day : Algiers / Bou-Saada / Laghouat

In the Morning departure for Bou-Saada, passing through the gorges of Chiffa that mark the border between northern Mediterranean and highland steppe announcing the Sahara. Visit of El Hamel Mill and Ferrero. Breakfast at hotel. In the afternoon continue the tour in Laghouat. Check in at the hotel(half board) orientation tour and visit the Marabout of Sidi Abdelkader. Sunset contemplation.

Third Day : Laghouat / Ain Sefra

After breakfast, early morning departure for the longest step of the circuit (near 450kms). Across over the vast highland steppe. Passage through Afou and El-Bayadh. Cold meals will be offered during the tour. Local visits to Ain El-Ouarka with the discovery of rock carvings of Tiout. Late afternoon Arrival to Ain Sefra. Check in at your hotel, dinner and overnight.

Fourth Day : Ain Sefra / Taghit / Beni-Abbes

After breakfast, departure to Bechar. City tour by bus and continue the tour to Taghit. Breakfast at the hotel. Relaxation. Visit the Oasis and rock carvings of Taghit. And continue the visit to Beni-Abbes. Check at your hotel, dinner and overnight stay.

In the afternoon, departure to El-Golea. Visit the Zenete fortress at the arrival. Check in at your hotel, dinner and overnight.

Seventh Day : El-Golea / Ghardaia

After breakfast, visit the tomb of the father Foucault in the small village of Bel-Bachir. Continue the tour to Ghardaia, Check in at the hotel(full board). In the afternoon, visit the palm grove of Ghardaia, the dam and its sharing system of flood waters of Wadi MZab. Visit the holy city of Beni-Isguen and its picturesque market at auction.

Eighth Day : Ghardaia / Laghouat / Bou-Saada

After breakfast, visit Ghardaia. Free time for shopping at the Ghardaia market. Departure around 10 am to Laghouat. Lunch at the hotel. In the afternoon, departure to Bou-Saada stopping at Djelfa. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

Ninth Day : Bou-Saada / Algiers

Breakfast at hotel and departure to Algiers through the gorges of Lakhdaria (eg Palestro). Visit Riadh El-Fath. Lunch in the center of the city. In the afternoon, city tour. Free time at the old Casbah and transfer to the package hotel, dinner and overnight.

In The Footsteps of Father Charles de Foucauld

Father Charles de Foucauld was born September 15th, 1858 in Strasbourg, he spent a long part of his life between Beni Abbas El Golea and Tamanrasset where he settled and died on December 1st, 1916.

The regions included in this program are both areas of resources and meditations for some and of isolation and self-seeking for others.



Program :

First Day : Algiers / Bechar (by air)

Arrival at Algiers airport connection flight to Bechar. Transfer to the package hotel. Dinner and overnight.

Second Day : Bechar / Beni Abbas

Situated at 83 km from south of Bechar, Taghit is an oasis where everything is harmony of shapes and colors. The cut flints, show a high density of population in these remote prehistoric times. Standing on the left bank of the Saoura, Beni Abbas was one of the Saharan Paleolithic places and Neolithic civilizations. Not far from the city, nestled in the field, stands the chapel that Father de Foucauld erected at the beginning of the century, where he lived for four years before moving in 1905, to settle permanently in Hoggar.

Third Day : Beni Abbas / Timimoun

Departure to Timimoun by the great western erg. Timimoun is built on the northern projection of Tademaït and is separated by high dunes and Sabkha palm rogues. Visit the caves of Ighzer, the old Ksar and the medieval village of Aghled.

Fourth Day : Timimoun / Ghardaïa

Departure to El Golea. City overlooked by the ruins of the old Ksar. Visit the tomb of Charles de Foucauld, Bel Bachir Church, first church of the Sahara, consecrated in 1838. Continue to Ghardaïa, visit the Beni Izguen city.

Fifth Day : Ghardaïa - Tamanrasset

Visit Ghardaïa before the flight to Tamanrasset. The capital of the M'Zab, was built in XI century. Famous for its irrigation system, handicrafts and especially its monuments. transfer to the airport.

Sixth Day : Tamanrasset

Visit the "Frégate", the oratory that Father de Foucauld built himself, Bordj and Fortin within which he was killed on December 1st, 1916. Discovery the market of Tamanrasset.

Seventh Day : Tamanrasset / Assekrem

Departure by 4x4 to the Hoggar Massif. Continue to Assekrem. In 1911, Charles de Foucauld remained five months in Assekrem Plateau. Rise and walk on the plateau of Assekrem. Visit to the chapel.

Eighth Day : Assekrem / Tamanrasset

At sunrise, walking up to the top of Assekrem (2710 m) to the hermitage of Father de Foucauld, which houses a chapel and a dwelling.

Ninth Day : Tamanrasset / Algiers

Transfer to the airport from Tamanrasset. Assistance for Departure.

The Kours of Timimoun

A route of choice in an area of choice between the lush oasis of Touat, and Tidikelt Gourara and where you can combine the pleasure of discovery and change of scenery.



Program :

7j



First Day : Arrival to Timimoun

Arrival in the afternoon to Timimoun. Check in at hotel, dinner and overnight.

Second Day : Timimoun / Fatis / M'Gaiden

In the Morning departure by 4x4 vehicles to the Grand Erg. Crossing the dunes, abandoned Kours Tin Firar, Ksar Kaddour, invaded by sand, whose locations reflect the defensive instinct of ancient populations in the region. Continue to visit to Fatis that is caulked in the middle of Western Erg, famous for its carpets today. Bivouac in the green valley of M'Gaiden.

Third Day : M'Gaiden / Tiberghamine / In Belbel

From there, the Tadmit plateau unfolds as far as the eye can see, and we already suspected on the horizon, the great void of Tanezrouit. The track borrows the beds of the great dry wadis to find the passage to Tiberghamine, then enters a series of flat rocks eroded towards In Belbel, miraculously rich center Tadmit. bivouac under the palm trees.

Fourth Day : In Belbel / Oufrane / Ksabit

We approach, here the Touat massif and its long green ribbon of oasis, passing by Tamentit, ancient religious capital, famous for its old Ksar, its black pottery, unique in Algeria, then a stop at Fémoughil site to explore the rock engravings. Late afternoon arrival at Ksabit oasis, reminiscent of the past eras, with unavoidable orientation tour in the capital of the Touat, Adrar, of Sudanese modern style used to be called "Timi".

Fifth Day : Ksabit / Taouza / Semdjane

By a secret track and forgotten, we head to the northwest, again, towards the foothills of the dune chains of the Grand Erg Occidental, which impedes our horizon to the north before we can reach Ta Ouenza, that is beautifully nestled at the foot of the dunes, irresistibly dotted with few palm trees. After the picnic and a slight journey on the sea sand, we reach Semdjane camp at the foot of a cliff. From the top, we can admire a panoramic views of Timimoun and Sebkhha.

Sixth Day : Semdjane / Semouta / Timimoun

Back to the south by a road bordering the Gourara massif until we reach Tala, collected Oasis, then Aghlad, Kali and Semouta, other paradise oasis, that are teased since the glory days of caravans, by advancing uninterrupted sand. In the evening, we go into the Timimoun depression which reveals its Sebkhha, old dry lake that will provide to the more fortunate, as goodbye gift, a bouquet of desert roses. Check in at hotel, dinner and overnight.

Seventh Day : Timimoun / Departure

After breakfast, transfer to airport. Assistance for departure.

Late afternoon Arrival at the shelter. Dinner and overnight.

Third Day : Assekrem / Hirafok / Ideles

In the morning after breakfast, departure through the gueltas road to Hirafok Targui village of, a station of rock engravings located in an area where vegetation is abundant. Bivouac in Hirafok. In the afternoon visit the rock engravings and paintings of the region : Assekrem, Qued Zarzoura, Immaara, then continue the tour with the discovery of Qued Inhamar, engravings and paintings on rock panels along the track until Ideles. Arrival at sunset. Camping and dinner.

Fourth Day : Ideles / Tazrouk

In the morning after the breakfast, departure to Tazrouk, passing through the Taderaz mountains. Arrival at Tazrouk, famous for the richness of its gardens and its Oasis, the miracle of the strange vegetation that flourishes continually in a wild and wonderful site. Camp for lunch at Qued Azrou. In the afternoon visit the surrounding areas and installation of the camp oriented to Aokasit, one of the finest rock needles of the Hoggar. Camping and dinner.

Fifth Day : Tazrouk / Tahifet / Tamekrest

In the Morning after breakfast, departure to Tahifet passing through Azrou Col, impressive and difficult track, descends and follows the course of Queds (rivers). Arrival at Tahifet, very tense village, extending in a green valley with varied vegetation. On the way, Camp for lunch. In the afternoon, continue the tour to Tamekrest and installation of the camp at the foot of the waterfall called "Tamekrest" or "the Impassable". Dinner and overnight.

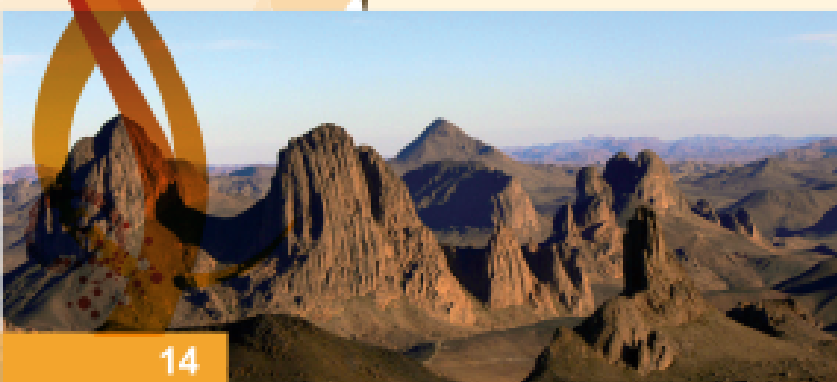

First Day : Djanet / Amails

Arrival at Djanet. Reception and transfer to the city. After noon, training on expedition and travel to Anails in 4x4 vehicle. Crossing of Tassili Ajjer cliffs by Tini rivers and Tilouine Nado. Bivouac at the river Amails.

Second Day : Amails / Indjaren

After breakfast, travel to the canyons of Indjaren river. Visit of several places of rock paintings and engravings while crossing the canyon by its left bank. Restoration and night stay in campsite.

Third Day: Indjaren / Tin-Merzouga

In the morning, starting from Tadrart plateau. You will discover a landscape with sandstone shapes carved by time and having a variety of colored sand dunes, in addition to sandstone and rock castles. Restoration and night stay in campsite.

Fourth Day: Tin-Merzougan / Moul-Ennaga

Further visit up to the regions of Moul-Ennaga containing a lot of mazes. Restoration and night stay in campsite.

Fifth Day : Moul-Ennaga / Alidemma

Departure toward the southwest to exit the Tadrart. Crossing the Imaharatene Tassili of a very special landscape characterized by carved and sculpted blocks of sandstone which are interspersed with wide avenues of blowing sand. Restoration and night stay in the campsite.

Sixth Day : Alidemma / In-Affellahlah

The itinerary of this visiting stage leads to the Erg Admer visit, with a passage in the Mountains of Tikarkar (eg Mount Gautier). Finally, the visit will take the direction of the northern side, late in the afternoon, to visit Tafassasset river. Restoration and night stay in the campsite.
